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

A dark tale of post-Iliad trauma, vengeance, sexual havoc, and threatened infanticide, composed by one of the early 18th century's most brilliant and under-recognized operatic masters, Leonardo Vinci. This is by far the most disturbing work Ars Minerva has revived, set in a topsyturvy world of grim beauty where mother love counts for little, erotic attraction excuses any cruelty, and conventional gender roles are reversed: Heroic males are at the mercy of their emotions, while women are the cold voice of duty and honor. Even death itself may not be what it seems in this lusty tale. Can a happy resolution be found?
